Latest from Tanzania - Steve here as I've escaped from the village for a night to go and see a water project the other EI personnel are working on and to take some photos. As such I've managed to jump in front of a computer and want to let everyone back in the UK know all's well. The team are working hard in the village and getting on really well with the building work as well as entertaining the children at the play club in the afternoons. Attendance is regularly up at 170 each day! Everyone in the group is still talking to each other although you'll be glad to know sun tans are not coming on as well as hoped as it's been a bit cloudy. Days are long and everyone's missing something or someone at home. Hopefully we'll be able to send more news again soon.

## **St Stephen's Church Graveyard**

Ground improvement work is being carried out on the Memorial Garden area of the St Stephen's church graveyard to add a special soil mix, re seed and improve the levels. This will necessitate moving plants and pots which have been placed near the memorial stones and they will be temporarily placed alongside the outer wall.
