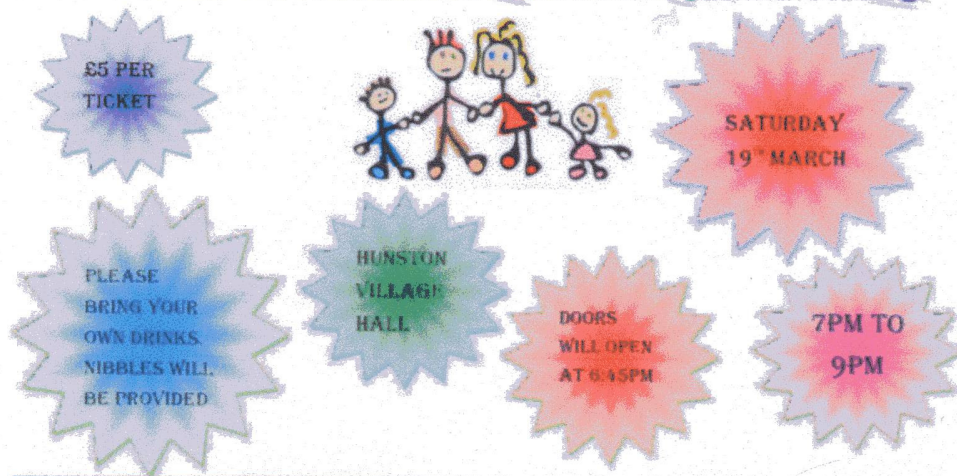


Sophie Morton and Kat Munden are 'cycling' to Tanzania
