Over the past 20 years, the Fairtrade mark has become the biggest and best known ethical label in the UK. **GOOD NEWS** - 78% of the UK public recognise the FAIRTRADE Mark. From UK sales alone, £26m of Fairtrade Premium was invested by producers in 2013. **But** we know there is still a long way to go to make all trade fair – **Fairtrade sales in the UK have declined by 4%** (maybe by consumers shopping more in Aldi/Lidl/Tesco who don't prioritise Fairtrade) & just 1.2% of cocoa and less than 10% of tea globally is traded on Fairtrade terms. By sharing their stories in a fresh and compelling way, we can remind the UK of the dramatic difference choosing Fairtrade makes and how much it is still needed. Dates to remember for Team Tanzania Fund Raising

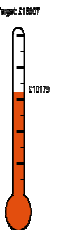
Easter Monday 6th April
