A letter from Alison Giblett Ukraine November 2014



Dear friends,

Thank you so very much for your prayers for Ukraine. There is so much that God is teaching us through this very difficult time in Ukraine. The pressure demonstrates where our foundations are. Are we looking for who is to blame or are we demonstrating God's practical love to all in need? Do we run to safety or are we like Queen Esther, willing to risk our own life to save others? There are many Christians that God has called to stay or even travel to the zone of conflict to provide both spiritual and practical support to the army and those who are, for whatever reason, unable to leave. Many people have been without water for months and the shops are practically empty or selling items at four times the price. Church leaders from our daughter churches have been bringing bread and water daily to people, often their own. Others have been bringing warm clothes and buying armoured breastplates for the soldiers.
