Everyone is most welcome!

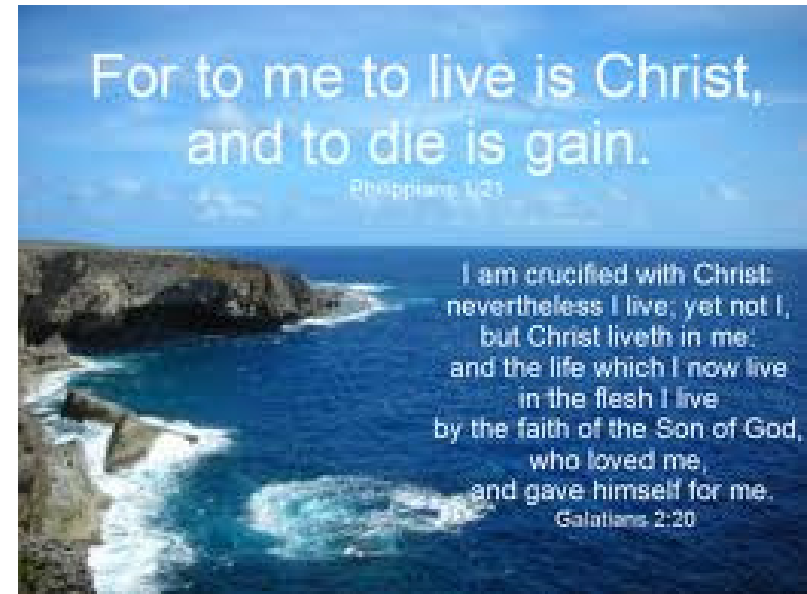
